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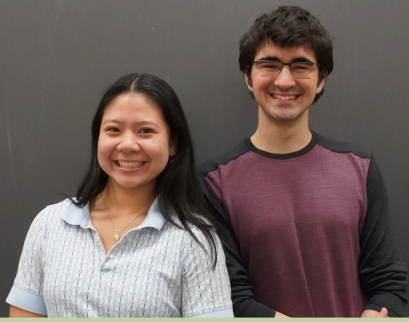
LEADERSHIP TEAM

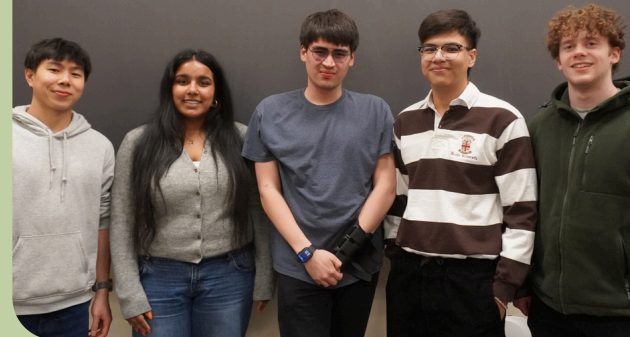

We expanded our Fellowship, a 6-week discussion-based program that covers the foundations of alt proteins. We led distinct science and policy tracks.



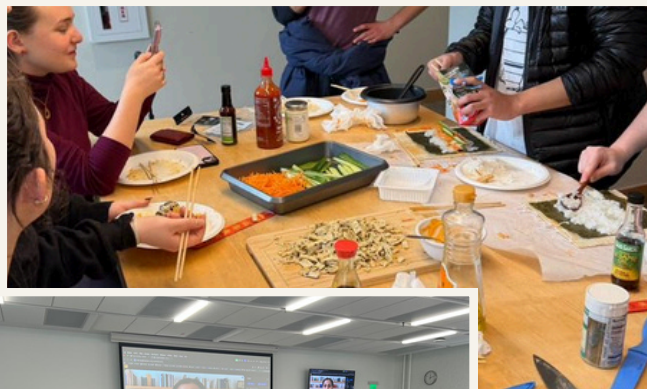
RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT
